Rishu, Jharkhand was previously called Chhotanagpur. Don't you get baffled by this? There is Nagpur and then there is a Chhota Nagpur?

RP: Sir, I never thought as to why that name is?

Make a guess. It is something related to the late 18th Early 19th Century.

RP: Sir, that period witnessed massive tribal revolts in the Deccan and similar uprisings were there in Chhotanagpur region. But I am not sure Sir.

Interrupted, looks like you don't want to answer that question. Ok next question. Jharkhand recently got separated from Bihar 2-3 years ago? Do you think the separation has been good?

RP: Sir Jharkhand got separated from Bihar in 2000. Sir the partition was mainly for the Tribal identity and tribal development. In terms of the social indicators like IMR, Literacy etc it has definitely improved and is performing better than Bihar and in some better than national average too.... Interrupted....

But is it due to partition or is it due to development?

RP: Sir, it is due to partition that a pinpointed focus on the tribals who constitute 27% of the population could take place... Interrupted..looked at the CM and said it was a very pin pointed question. Anyway I am done.
